

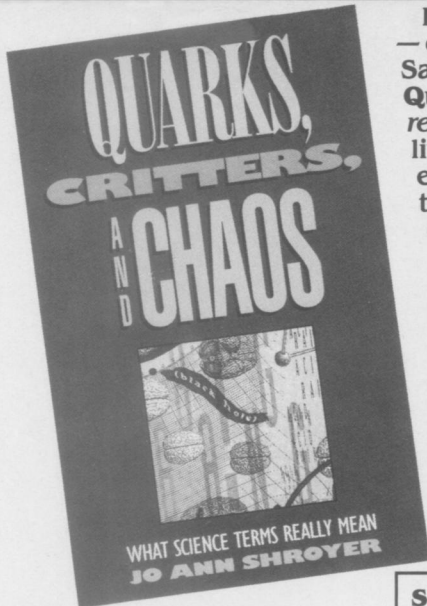

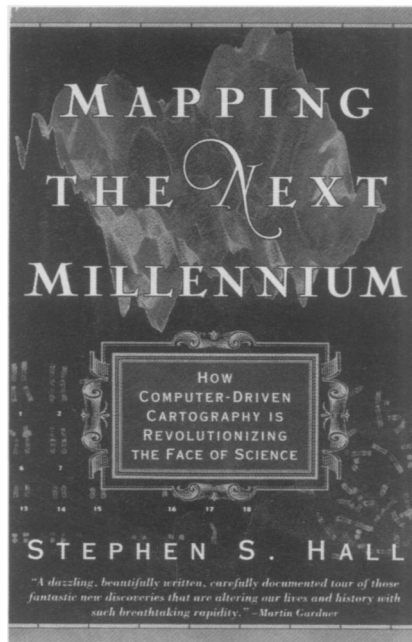

Much as the compass and the ship allowed explorers to map the globe five hundred years ago, dazzling new technologies have allowed present-day scientists — from astronomers to neuroscientists, geneticists to mathematicians — to map altogether new and strange terrains. 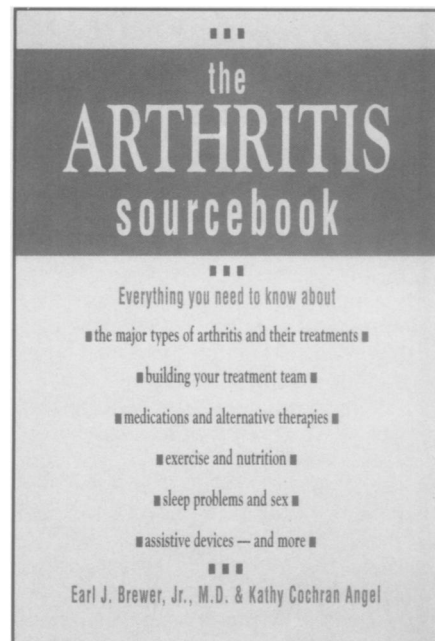

# EARTHQUAKES

**BRUCE A. BOLT**

Recent earthquakes in California, Armenia, and the Philippines were vivid reminders of the awesome destructive power of these natural phenomena. Bruce Bolt's descriptions of the origins, impact, and aftermath of these and other famous quakes make this revision of *Earthquakes* timely and compelling.

*Earthquakes* explains what is now known about the causes, occurrence, and physical properties of seismic activity. With a wealth of new information and evocative new illustrations, this new edition takes its place as the most up-to-date and accessible introduction to earthquake science available.

In addition, the book provides an engrossing look at how seismographic studies have helped us lessen the danger of earthquakes by enabling us to predict future quakes • explore the earth's interior • design earthquake-resistant structures (including schools and skyscrapers) • and devise effective preparedness, survival, and relief strategies.
