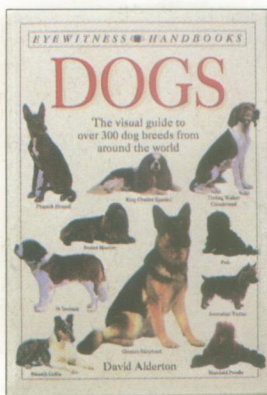


Go Dog Wild!

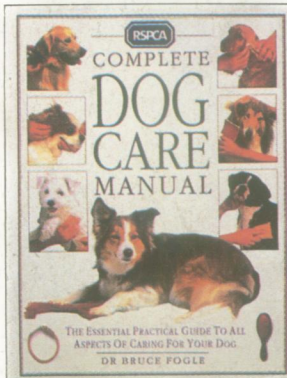
