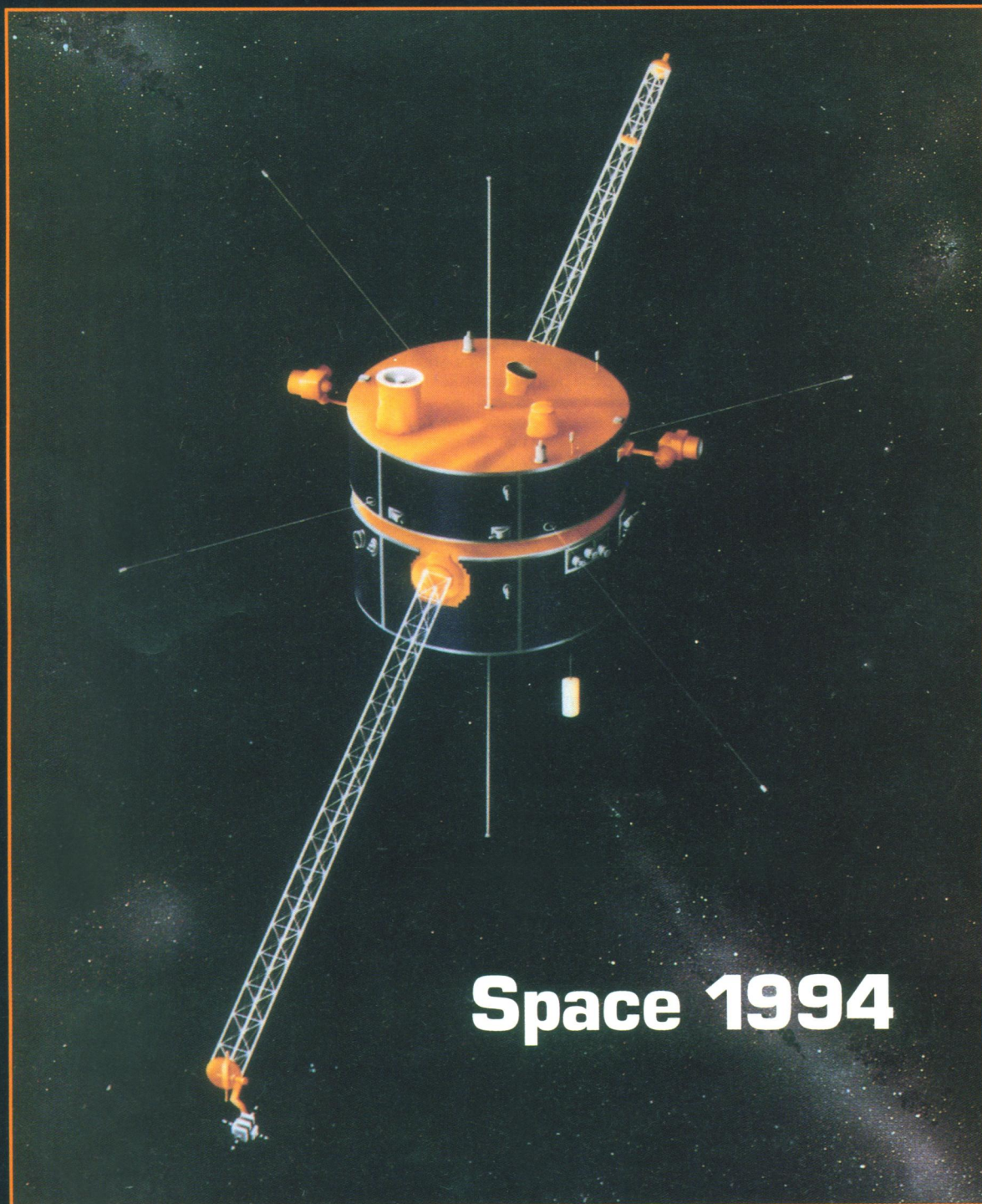

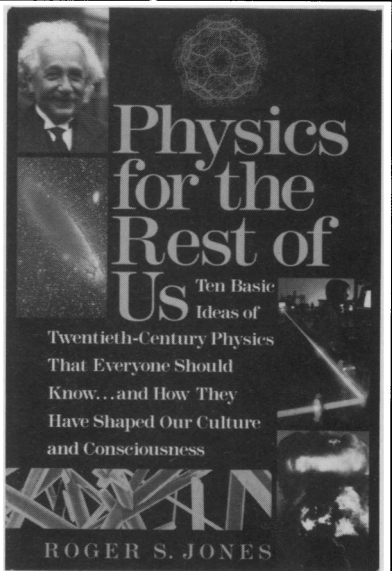
Jones also explores the impact of these ideas on humanist, ethical, psychological, aesthetic, and spiritual concerns, addressing such questions as:
