Wetlands: Life in a Freshwater Marsh

Freshwater wetlands make up nearly 95 percent of all wetlands in the lower 48 states. They include wet meadows, bottomland swamps, and the borders of rivers, lakes, and ponds. Although these habitats comprise only a fraction of the total North American land area, their life-giving waters and unique vegetation host a remarkable mosaic of creatures.

Wetlands: Life in a Saltwater Marsh

Only 5 percent of all wetlands in the 48 contiguous United States are found near saltwater, but they host a unique array of wildlife suited to survive the changing tides and high salinity. Their waters are a nursery for countless fish. Detritus—a rich stew of decaying plants and tiny organismsattracts animals as odd as the fiddler crab, as beautiful as the snowy egret. Millions of shorebirds find food for their long migrations on the marsh's mudflats.

Rivers of Life

There are many species of plants and animals that live only in or alongside rivers; many others must be near rivers to survive. In addition to fish and other aquatic animals, many species of wildlife are attracted to rivers because of the abundant insects and diverse plant life.

More than two-thirds of the planet is covered with ocean. This water world is home to countless kinds of plants and animals. Go down to the shore, like the rocky Atlantic coast pictured in this painting. All around you is an abundance of life, from periwinkles clinging to rocks, to terns wheeling overhead in search of fish.
