Brenders celebrates the Blue Heron in "Lord of the Marshes." Though seemingly at rest, the "lonely fisherman" remains intensely alert, carefully monitoring every movement in its surroundings. Blue dragonflies, arrow grass, and cattails complement this stately portrait of life in the marsh.

Uniting imagination with carefully crafted talent and strict attention to physical perfection, Carl Brenders' paintings capture his subjects as they live and breathe. Nature artist Brenders meticulously details his exquisite subjects and their habitats. A dedicated conservationist, Brenders' art is a testimonial to his love of nature.

Forever a creature of wonder and mystery, Brenders' lone wolf lies in quiet contemplation, deceptively resembling a domestic dog. Moss and lichens on the rocks add realism to the wolf's natural habitat.



The Family Tree

The winsome, luminous eyes of the saw-whet owl have earned it the nickname "Acadian adorable." Brenders found these seven-inch charmers on a trip to Alaska. The owls in "The Family Tree" gaze at the viewer with the trust in their eyes that makes them enchanting to humans, whom the saw-whet seems not to fear.



Autumn Lady

Unlike most nature artists, Brenders chooses the innocent and enchanting gaze of a whitetail doe over her male counterpart. A chance encounter with such a creature in Canada inspired this portrait, which captures the doe's innate beauty and grace against a backdrop of autumn leaves.
