Though undernourished, the young raptor, named Stripey, fared well. In time, Terman began teaching Stripey survival skills in a barn. When he felt the owl was ready to leave the nest, so to speak, Terman equipped it with radio tags so he could monitor its movements and progress. Remarkably, the owl thrived, and the radio tags enabled Terman to witness the daily grind of a bird's life, including courtship, warfare, and diving for prey. Leakey delves into what scientists know about human origins and what arguments remain to be settled. He does this by describing his own fossil-hunting expeditions and expounding upon his study of the personal behavior, social organization, and culture of humans. The Pinball Effect: How Renaissance Water Gardens Made the Carburetor Possible-And Other Journeys Through Knowledge-James Burke. Just as many inventions and thoughts interconnect, or pinball, through time, so does Burke's look at this effect. The author incorporates a hotlink approach to connect the "gateways" he discusses. This allows readers to possibly read the book 447 different ways as one pinballs from chapter to chapter or sticks to the traditional method. For instance, one can follow how spicy food in medieval times led to zoos, locomotives, air conditioning, and modern bombs, or see how plastic wrap is linked to one of the most famous clocks in the world, among many other successions in invention. 
