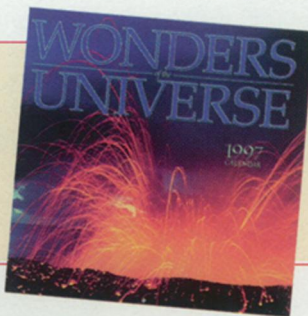
Images in Stone

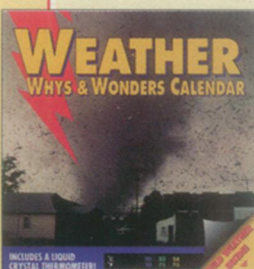
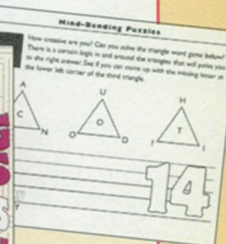
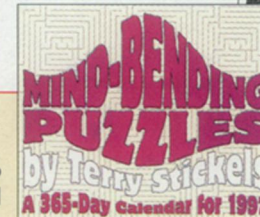
