

Since Westerners' first contact with EASTER ISLAND (Rapa Nui) nearly 3 centuries ago, the people, culture,

and, most of all, the monolithic statues of this remarkable island have seemed a riddle with no solution. At the heart of the so-called mystery of Easter Island stand the gigantic moai, the supreme sculptural achievement of the Rapa Nui.

Here, nearly 1,000

statues have been meticulously measured, drawn, mapped, and photographed by archaeologist Jo Anne Van Tilburg and her colleagues. The lat-

est methods of statistical analysis, computer imaging, and robotics programs are brought to bear upon the perplexing question of statue transport, and the author offers an exciting, compelling logical model of how a nearly 14-ton statue could have been moved almost the entire length of the island. — from Smithsonian Institution Press


