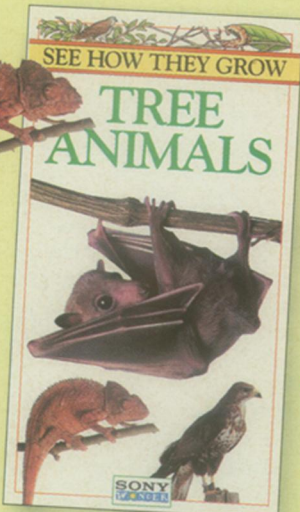


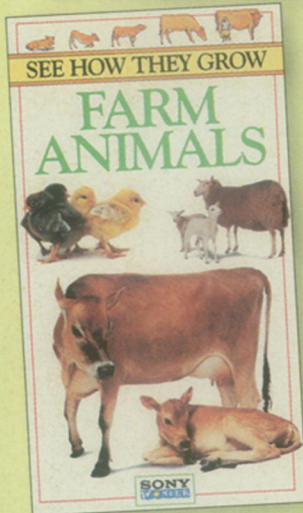
See Science Inside and Out

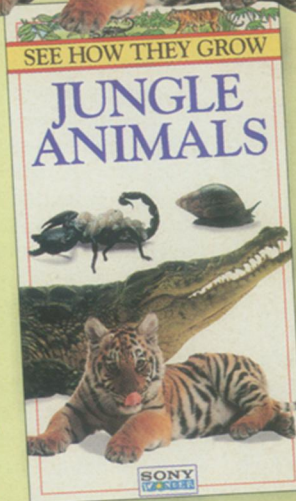

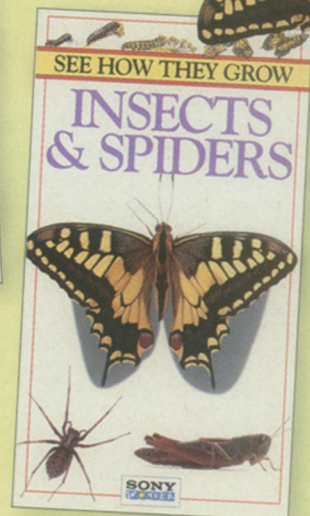
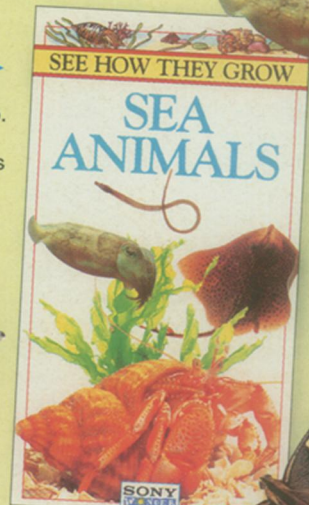
See how the lush, green jungle offers a perfect place to grow up strong and healthy for a little scorpion, alligator, snail, and two terrific, tiny tigers.
