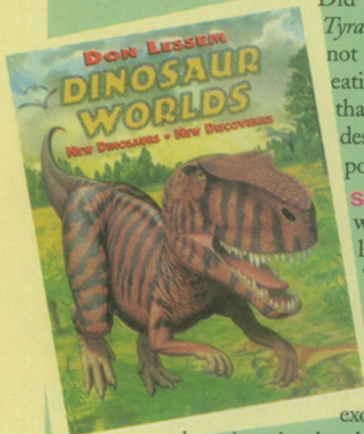
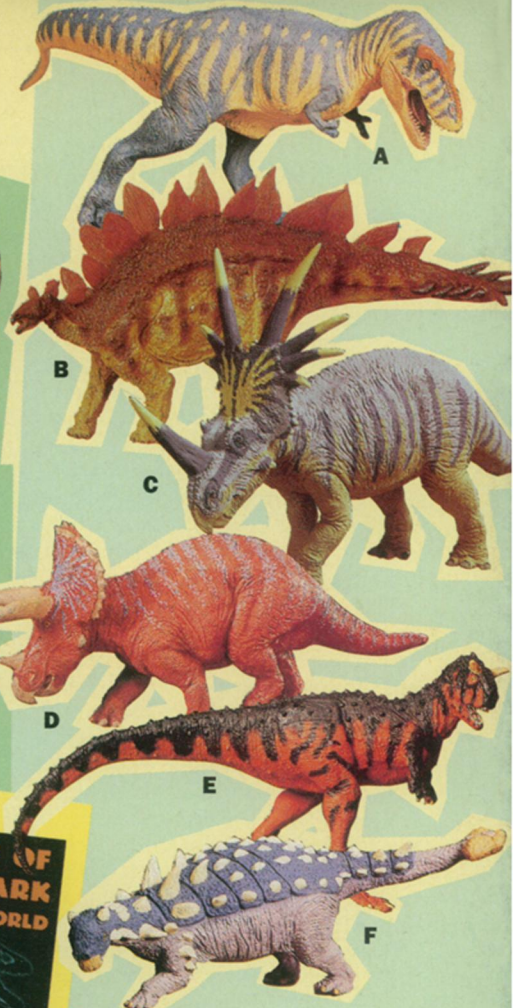
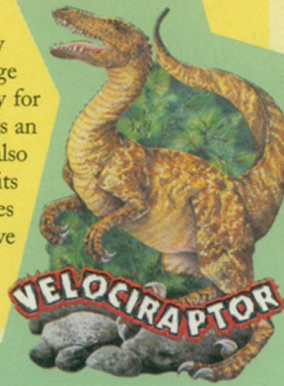


# Creature Features

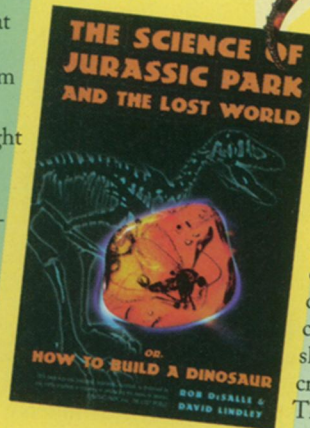
## The Science of Jurassic Park

## Dinosaur Models!

Created in collaboration with the Museum of Science in Boston, these 1/40-scale dinosaur models incorporate all that is currently known about the bone structure, skin texture, and movement of these creatures to create amazingly real replicas. The rubber construction lends itself to tough youngsters eager to play indoors and out with their new prehistoric companions.

**A. *Tyrannosaurus rex*** This is probably the most famous of the dinosaurs because of its tremendous 5-foot long skull and toothy, cavernous mouth. Model measures 12". \$9.95

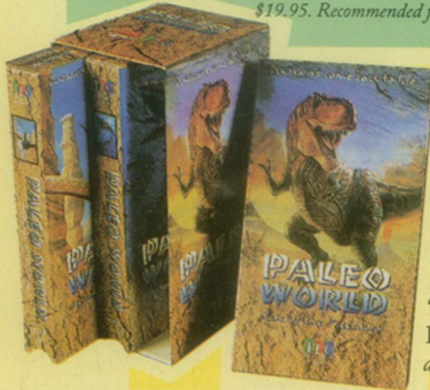
**B. *Stegosaurus unguatus*** The largest of the known stegosaurs, this creature has eight plates on its back. Model measures 7". \$5.95

**C. *Styracosaurus albertensis*** Weighing in at 2 tons, this spiky monster roamed the planet some 10 million years earlier than *Triceratops*. Model measures 6". \$5.95

**D. *Triceratops horridus*** Named for the three horns on its massive skull, *Triceratops* was one of the longest lasting dinosaur species. Model measures 7 1/2". \$6.95

**E. *Carnotaurus sastrei*** This theropod features a pair of bony horns above its eyes and extremely short arms. Fossil remains have been found in South America. Model measures 7". \$6.50

**F. *Euoplocephalus tutus*** Although a vegetarian, *Euoplocephalus* was well-equipped to fend off carnivores with its clublike tail and bony body armor. Model measures 6". \$6.95
