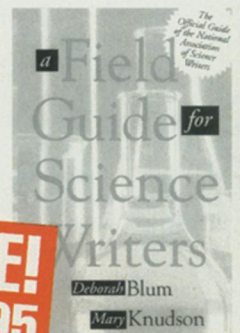
"Biophilia" is the term coined by Edward O. Wilson, author of *The Diversity of Life*, to describe what he believes is our innate affinity for the natural world.
