With two documentaries and 10 journeys to the depths of the Amazon rain forest behind him, O'Connor reflects on his experiences with the native Yanomami Indians and gold miners in the midst of a modern-day gold rush. O'Connor's story turns out to be more than simply one of miners raping the land and victimizing the Yanomami. In fact, his own role as observer becomes murky as he progresses. However, he is adept at unraveling these intricacies as well as the effects wrought by humanitarians trying to help with their Save the Rain Forest campaign. The Chunnel: The Amazing Story of the Undersea Crossing of the English Channel-Drew Fetherston. The project's lead engineer likens the building of the Channel Tunnel to the construction of the pyramids. Fetherston's story bounces from coast to coast as he illustrates the work habits and expertise of the English and French laborers, as well the financial wrangling necessary to accomplish such a massive undertaking.
