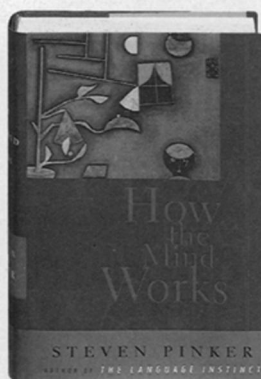

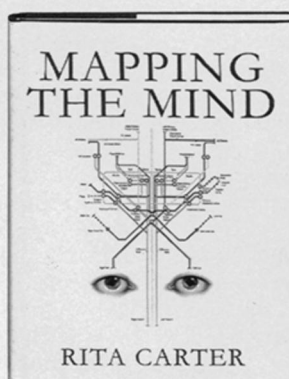

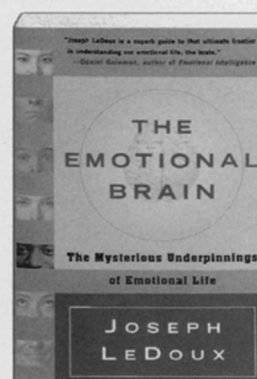

THE EMOTIONAL BRAIN
by Joseph LeDoux

Why do we seem to have little control over our emotional reactions? According to the author, it's because the connections from our emotional systems to our cognitive systems are so powerful. LeDoux shows that, contrary to previous claims about the limbic system, there is no single brain system responsible for emotions. Instead, numerous systems are involved, each evolving for different purposes and yielding different emotions, so emotions must be studied individually to discover their underlying mechanisms.
