(Either criterion works equally well, depending on whether you start from special relativity or from Yukawa's interpretation of the uncertainty principle. The relationship between range and mass of intermediate particles is derived from the uncertainty principle and this allows them to be compared with one another. A graviton with mass would go slower than the speed of light, just as pions, the intermediate particle in strong interactions, are known to do. Ed.)

#### Clarification

The first paragraph of my letter (SN: 5/10, p. 445) may have served to obscure rather than illustrate my basic argument. A typographical transposition makes it sound as though Amitai Etzioni in his article on "basic human needs" is proposing that aggression is "an instinctive territorial imperative." The term is not Etzioni's but is associated with Robert Ardrey's book "The Territorial Imperative." Etzioni does not posit aggression as a basic human need in his article in the December 1968 AMERICAN SOCIOLOGICAL RE-VIEW.

My reason for mentioning Etzioni, Ardrey and Parson's ideas in connection with my previous letter was that they all seem illustrative, in one way or another, of a relatively deterministic view of human conduct which leaves little room for human adaptiveness


