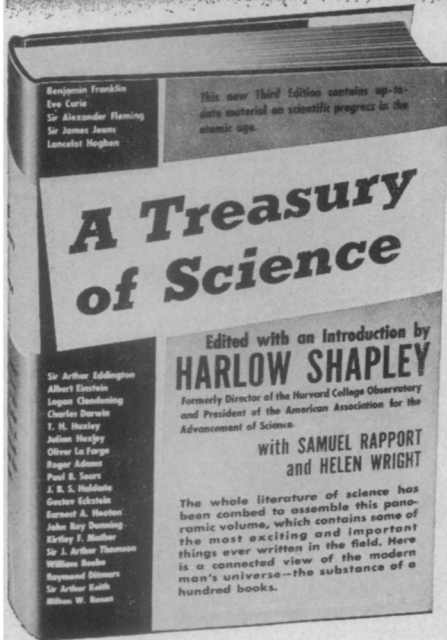
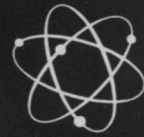

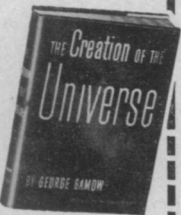
THE CREATION of the UNIVERSE

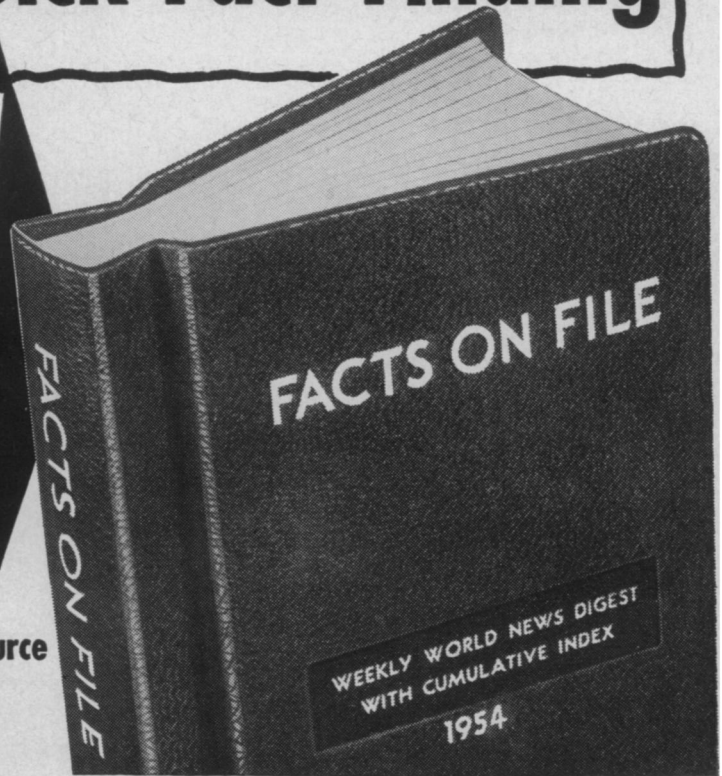
