The distance from Seattle to Tokyo is 4,770 miles via the "great circle" route.

Sago starch, used for adhesives and sizing, comes from the pithy center of the East Indies sago palm tree.

The "tin can" is about 99% steel, yet its extremely thin tin plating accounts for more than half the tin consumption in the U. S.

The first nuclear *reactor* for industrial research will be established at Armour Research Foundation of Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago.

Made from the root of the cassava plant, *tapioca* is used for food and as a postage stamp adhesive.

Rejected *sandpaper* is more than a manufacturing loss; it cannot be used for a new batch and it will not even burn.

Non-brittle *ceramic* coatings can now be applied to a broad variety of materials as a result of a new process.
