

### LANE—Animal Biology

The present book has been written primarily to present the animal as a living organism. Textbooks with this point of view, have usually been faulty in that they present the general principles without first laying a foundation in morphology. On the other hand, those that have given an adequate knowledge of morphology are built on the plan of "types" and pay slight attention to general principles. The book records an effort to steer between the two extremes; morphology is stressed, but extended systematic review of the phyla has been avoided, and the greater part of the discussion has to do with general principles.
