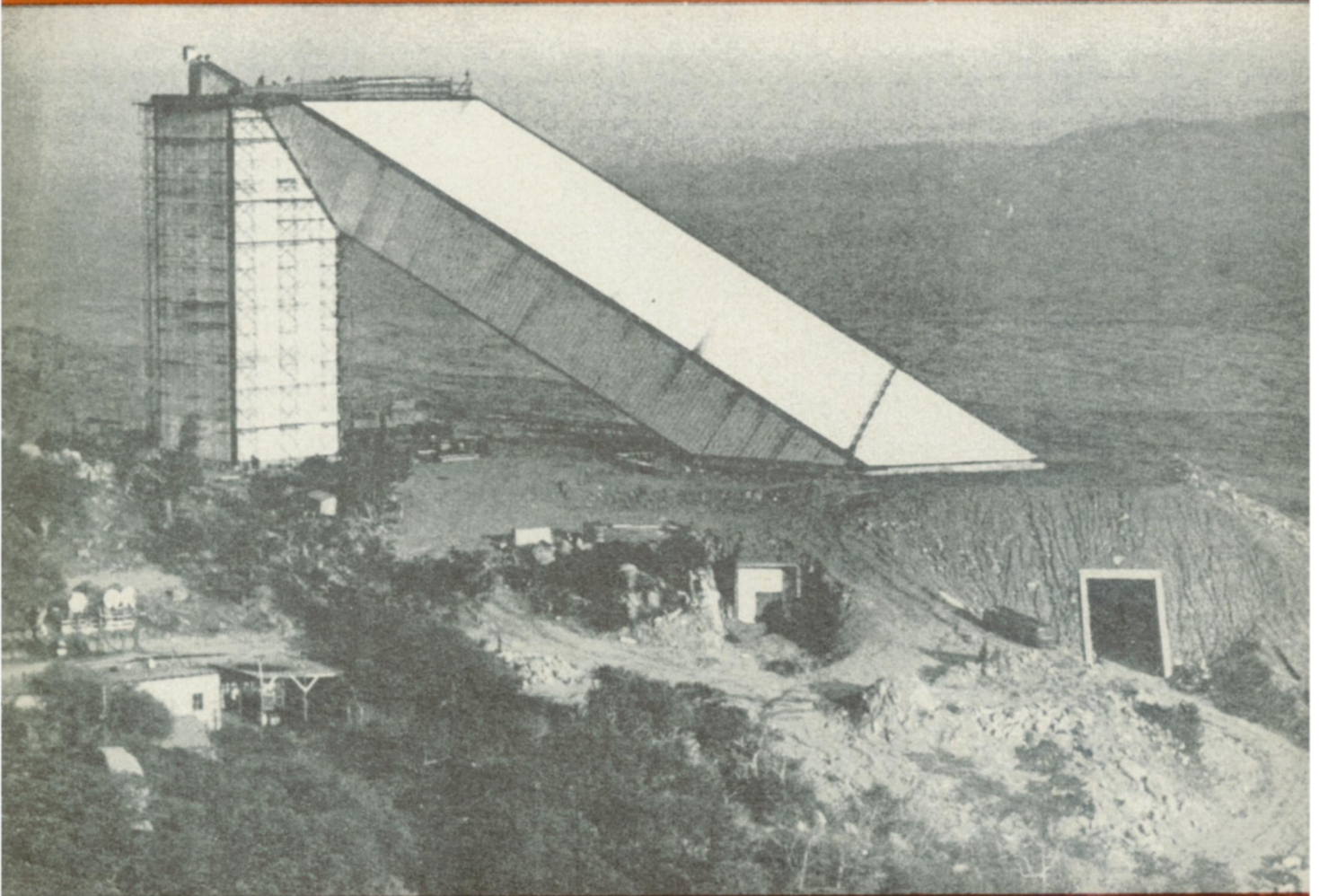

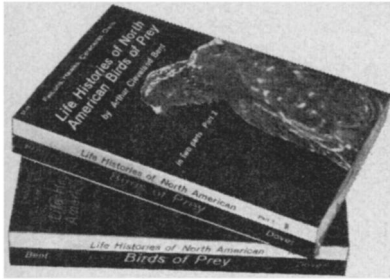

Available for the first time in many years, the monumental study of American birds

LIFE HISTORIES OF NORTH AMERICAN BIRDS OF PREY

by A. C. Bent Two volume set only \$4.70



The late A. C. Bent, dean of American ornithologists, spent the greater part of his lifetime in compiling his twenty-volume masterwork on North American birds. This work, which was prepared under the auspices of the Smithsonian Institution, and which has been accepted by all authorities as the definitive statement on American birds, has long been out of print, and individual volumes of it have brought fabulous prices on the rare book market. We have decided to reissue this enormously useful set in separate volumes, just as it was originally printed. Our first two volumes, "Birds of Prey," Part One and Part Two, are now ready for immediate delivery. These volumes are by far the fullest and richest works on American birds of prey. Bent deals with 114 birds in all—condors, vultures, hawks, eagles, falcons and owls—and analyzes carefully but interestingly the knowledge about each. He covers nesting, courtship, eggs and their care, young, plumages, behavior,

voice, field marks, enemies, range, typical and casual records, egg-laying dates, breeding ranges, winter ranges and migration, migration dates (where possible), and everything else that is necessary for each bird. Completely modern in approach, these books draw upon the work of thousands of observers—Bent served as a clearing house for all bird observations—and are therefore based upon detailed specific observations of flocks and individuals throughout the country, from the ice-islands of the Arctic to the jungles of Central America. Despite its scholarly stature, however, this set is a delight to read; no previous knowledge of biology or ornithology is needed to follow it in all its detail. It is personable and chatty in style, often narrative, and will offer hours of enjoyment to anyone interested in birds. The complete textual coverage is supplemented by 195 full-page plates, showing 363 photos

of birds in all types of activity. These are shots of living birds, made under difficulties that were often appalling. It is unlikely that Bent's monumental work will ever be superseded, or even equalled. It is the most comprehensive, most complete, and most-used single source about birds, and as such it should be a part of the collection of every high school, college and municipal library. Certainly no ornithologist, amateur naturalist or bird watcher should be without it. All that is worth knowing about American birds is to be found here. Unabridged reprinting of 1937-8 edition.
