An American-French joint expedition unearthed the mosaic, pronounced one of the earliest representations of Mediterranean fish ac-cording to species. Prof. E. G. Conklin, Princeton University, has identified clam, scallop, eel, sturgeon, a variety of squid, and members of the bass and mackerel families. Of the 11 species depicted, two remain unrecognized.
